# ONGOING PROJECT ANNAI TUITION CENTRE

A free Annai Tuition Center was started in Kuchipalayam village for the benefit of students of classes 5th to 12th Standard. This center was inaugurated by the Cuddalore District Secretary of the Vidhuthalai Chiruththai Party. Mr. Mullaivendhan

presided and inaugurated Tution Centre.

Appreciating the service of Annai Foundation and felicitated the students. These free evening classes are taught by well-trained private school teachers who have completed teacher training Mr. Vimalraj and Mr. Both Vijayan are coming



and taking classes for free of both boys and girls in this village. Also in this event was Keezarungunam Panchayat Council member Mr. Ramakrishna and important people of the town attended.





More than 10 students gets directly benefited (Education) from Annai Tution Centre with the professional teachers from various private schools.

## **AZOLLA PROJECT**

In the Keezh Arungunam and Natham villages of the Annagramam Panchayat Union, a program was initiated to provide nutrition to livestock—such as goats, cows, and chickens—which significantly support the economic well-being of farmers, while simultaneously reducing the cost of animal feed.

Farmers in these villages have been able to cut down on expenses for traditional feeds like bran, oil cake, and commercial poultry feed by cultivating and harvesting Azolla in a simple manner and using it as a supplemental feed for their livestock.

This initiative started with raising awareness among farmers about Azolla cultivation. The

program, which began in February 2021, continues to be implemented successfully to this day.

Through this initiative, explanatory sessions on Azolla cultivation were conducted for farmers in the neighboring villages. Furthermore, a large number of farmers receive Azolla culture (or seed) for free. Consultation and advice on Azolla cultivation are also provided to interested farmers.

# OUTREACH ACTIVITIES FIRST - AID AWARENESS

The core objective of the one-day program was to empower individuals with essential life-saving skills needed during crises. The training focused specifically on:

- Natural Disasters and Emergencies: Providing aid to victims during unforeseen events like floods, storms, or other large-scale accidents.
- Accident Victims: Immediate and effective first response for individuals injured in traffic accidents or other common mishaps.
- Basic Life Support (BLS): Practical demonstrations of techniques like CPR (Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation) and controlling severe bleeding.

The aim was to foster a community of proactive first responders who could stabilize a victim before professional medical help arrives, thereby significantly increasing the chances of survival and recovery.

The importance of the initiative was highlighted by the presence of key figures:

- The program was formally launched by the Founder of TKY Health Care Consultancy, who likely emphasized the crucial role of immediate aid in saving lives.
- The attendance and address by the Neyveli
   First Aid Training Neyveli

   Police Inspector underscored the administration's support for public safety and a emergency preparedness, validating the program's significance.



# **CHILD LABOUR AWARENESS**

To observe World Day Against Child Labour on June 12 and to raise awareness about the issue of child Labor, an awareness rally was held in A. Kuchipalayam village within the Annagramam Union.

Rally Activities: Participants in the rally carried placards denouncing child Labor and chanted awareness slogans. This was a concerted effort to visibly and vocally communicate the severity of the issue to the local community.

#### **Inauguration and Key Figures:**

The rally was formally inaugurated by Mr. Thanikachalam, a teacher from the Government Higher Secondary School in Nellikuppam, who waved the flag to commence the procession.
